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At its production facility in Rösztke, Hungary, Unilever Hungary installed a Meypack VP 453 case packer to pack Doypacks and 4-sealed-edge pouches in display trays with lids partially inserted and partially applied to the outside of the tray. On the long side of the tray, the lid is partially inserted into the tray and secured with adhesive points against slippage. The machine can process diverse formations that are dependent upon the respective size of the pouches. In addition, so-called double chamber pouches can also be processed. The changeover to different tray formats takes place nearly tool-free. Grouping the pouches is carried out with the help of a pivoting stacking shaft that places the product formations directly on a tray blank as soon as the desired number of pouches has been reached.

In the Hungarian village of Rösztke, Unilever Hungary produces food products for 17 European countries, with Hungary, Austria, Poland and Czech Republic at the top of the list. The production facility in Rösztke is located south of Budapest, near the Romanian border.
