At the company CSM in Delmenhorst, Germany, there are two Meypack VP 451 case packers in operation. The machines pack blocks and slabs of margarine into wrap-around cases for industrial and confectionary purposes. The machines have been designed to ensure gentle handling of the products during processing, given that the blocks and slabs of margarine are not completely firm when leaving production. Furthermore, the product transport is extremely gentle in order to prevent the flaps of the wrapping material (aluminium, HDPE, PP, PE or paper) from opening or creasing. The margarine blocks are packed in two layers while the margarine slabs are packed in layers of five. The second machine can pack wrap-around cases with flush-lying side flaps and overlapping side flaps. Both machines were delivered in stainless steel.
