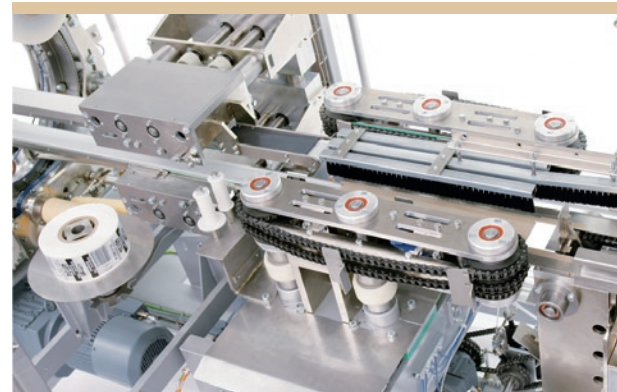

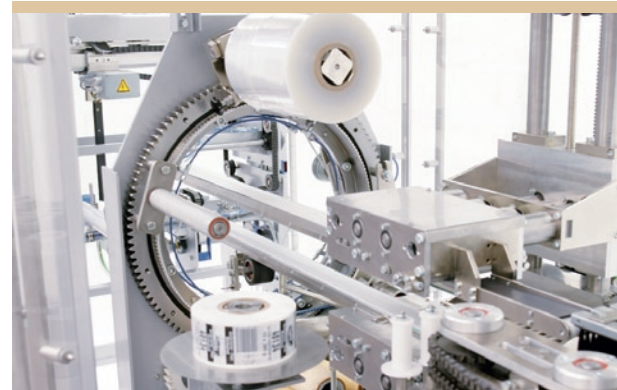


At R&R's production facility in the French town of Vayres, folding boxes containing ice cream cones are packed by an FW 201 stretch-film wrapper. The folding boxes enter the machine lying down and are erected by a paddle chain. Then, depending upon the respective pack size the boxes are transported standing upright, one behind the other, to the separating station. The bundle created is then wrapped continuously with stretch-film before it is cut free by an automatic cutting system at the machine discharge.

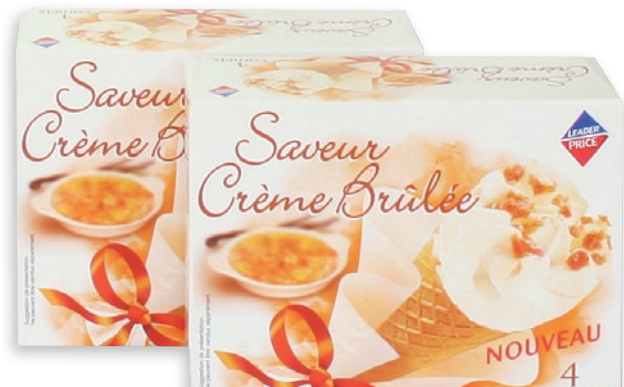
